Hillsdale Lily Garden officially opened nearly a decade ago, and 2026 will mark its tenth anniversary. Since those early days, the business has continued to grow steadily. Each year has brought new gardens, new varieties, and new visitors discovering the diversity of daylilies for the first time.



For Lu and Todd, being owner operators means being closely connected to every part of the business. Both have deep agricultural roots in Iowa, having grown up around farming through parents and grandparents. That shared background gives them a strong understanding of the land and the work it takes to care for it.
