They partner with farmers from system design to harvest, providing market access and sales support to ensure a premium product from tank to table.



Sarah Kimle, Jackson's wife and Midland Co.'s operations and communications manager, explains, "Our focus is on quality, consistency and transparency. We want our customers to know exactly where their shrimp comes from and the care that goes into raising it."

The farm produces Pacific white shrimp, prized for their clean, robust flavor and lobster-like richness. Customers often find them perfect for both special occasions and weeknight meals, with head-on shrimp offering an extra punch of flavor for chefs and seafood enthusiasts.

What excites Midland Co. most about Iowa agriculture is the chance to help farmers diversify their operations, introduce younger generations to innovative farming and build a resilient food system in the Midwest. In 2026, the company plans to expand from three farms to four additional locations, continuing to scale while staying true to their mission of sustainability and community connection.
